AthFest Health & Safety Information

We are excitedly planning for the annual AthFest Music & Arts Festival on September 24-26, 2021, in beautiful downtown Athens, GA.

The safety of attendees, artists, staff, and volunteers remains our top priority. AthFest is working closely with local health and public safety officials and will follow current Athens-Clarke County requirements for special events related to COVID-19 at the time of the festival.

We encourage everyone to take the CDC-recommended steps to protect yourself and our community from COVID-19.

This year's AthFest is a fully outdoor event.

Vaccines

- While vaccinations are not currently mandated by state and/or local guidelines to attend this year's AthFest, they are **strongly encouraged**.

Masks

- Masks are **strongly encouraged** for all AthFest attendees.
- All AthFest staff and volunteers will be required to wear masks while working at the festival.

Exposures and Symptoms

- Please not attend AthFest if you have tested positive, or been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, within 14 days of the festival.
- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms within 48 hours of the festival, please do not attend AthFest.

Additional Health and Safety Measures

- New festival layout that allows for more stage viewing space.
- Reduced number of vendor spaces that allows attendees to have more space to move freely around the festival area.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the AthFest beer tents, the AthFest merchandise tent, and the KidsFest activity tent. AthFest vendors have also been asked to provide hand sanitizer at each booth.
